Valley Youth House

Runs a Pride program providing housing and supportive services for LGBTQ youth. The organization also assists youth in attaining educational goals and finding employment, and runs shelters in Lehigh Valley and Bucks County.

Project HOME

Provides supportive services and helps youth establish permanent housing. Soon opening a new residence for 30 LGBTQ homeless youth in North Philadelphia.

Covenant House

Assists youth in achieving independence and finding employment, with connections to medical, educational, vocational, and religious services. Crisis shelter open 24/7/365 with 76 beds. An additional 20 beds available in the Transitional Living program.

Offers immediate housing to youth who are homeless or unable to safely stay with family. Open to ages 12-17, with connections to medical care, counseling, educational and recreational programming.
